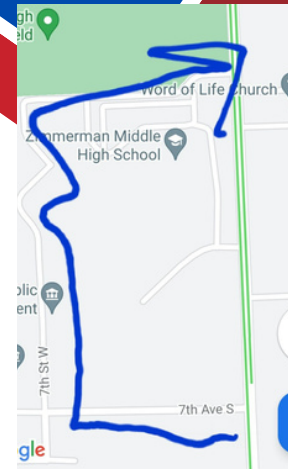


# WILD WEST DAYS 2023 PARADE ENTRY FORM
